As you are aware that four sons of Shri Guru Gobind Singh ji were martyred and this supreme sacrifice is commemorated every year.

The eldest son of Shri Guru Gobind Singh ji, Sahibzada Ajit Singh was born in Paonta Sahib, Himachal Pradesh. The other three namely Sahibzada Jhujhar Singh, Sahibzada Zorawar Singh, Sahibzada Fateh Singh were born and brought up in Shri Anandpur Sahib along with elder brother Sahibzada Ajit Singh.

The supreme sacrifice of Sahibzadas Zorawar Singh and Fateh Singh is to be commemorated as Veer Bal Diwas by Government of India all over the country.

Shri Guru Gobind Singh along with family left Shri Anandpur Sahib. During battles on the way Sahibzada Ajit Singh and Jhujhar Singh were martyred at Chamkur Sahib, while fighting the Mughal forces. Sahibzada Zoravar Singh and Fateh Singh were captured from Village Kheri/Sehri by the Mughals, kept at Morinda at the night and sent to Sirhind in captivity where they refused to convert to Islam and were martyred.

However so far no Govt. institution has been named after the Sahibzadas to commemorate the supreme sacrifice either at Shri Anandpur Sahib or Shri Chamkur Sahib or Morinda or at Sirhind. The places connected with their life sacrifice.

I shall be thankful if the Govt. of Punjab may kindly consider the following request:-

1. Educational Institution may kindly be opened at Shri Anandpur Sahib, Chamkur Sahib, Morinda or at Sirhind the place related to Sahibzada's history to commemorate the supreme sacrifice.
2. The road from Morinda to Sirhind may be named after Sahabzada Zoravar Singh and Shabzada Fateh Singh.
3. A museum depicting the life history of Sahabzadas may be established at Fatehgarh Sahib or may be added to Viraste Khalsa of Anandpur Sahib.
