

The Noorul Uloom Education Society is an initiative of the alumni of Aligarh Muslim University founded in 1989. This society has taken the responsibility of promoting education for students of all communities in Hathras but with particular reference to children of the Muslim community. The effort is to provide maximum exposure and opportunity in all fields including academic, sports, co-curricular, moral, cultural, and social with the overriding objective of providing quality education to students as well as nurture the individual potential of each student who enrolls in the schools. The outreach of these schools has continued to grow.

The Mission of Noorul Uloom Education Society is to provide modern and oriental education simultaneously and to eliminate poverty by eradicating illiteracy and providing technical and industrial training. Their other mission is to ensure safe and secured future for the backward communities especially the Muslim minority so as to assimilate them in the mainstream while retaining their social, cultural, and religious identity. At present, Noorul Uloom Education Society is running twelve schools including an Islamic residential Madarsa, which are as follows:

- A. Higer Secondary School- 1
- B. Junior High School- 2
- C. Primary schools- 8
- D. Madarsa- 1

The schools provide residence for teachers. English is compulsory. Laboratories and the library are well equipped and furnished to accommodate a large number of students. There are a total of 607 students on school rolls, with 21 teachers. The school organizes various functions and co-curricular activities for students. The School also organizes weekly competitions on different events of literary, cultural, sporting, and Seerat activities throughout the academic session. There are annual intra-school competitions on all these events during the month of January/ February every year followed by an Annual Prize Distribution Ceremony.

There have been many achievements that have been stated below:

1. Hostel building for the Madarsatu Al-Shah Abrarul Haque was commissioned and is in use by the students.
2. Twelve residences for teachers were constructed, commissioned and are in use.
3. NUES organized Inter-School competitions in literary and cultural activities including debates, general knowledge, Baitbazi, essay writing and drama. The Society also organized competitions on Seerat-e-Pak including Qirat, Na'at Khwani, Gen. Knowledge and speches on Seerat. This was followed by the

prize Distribution Ceremony, the Annual Function, on 19th Feb, 2012. Prof. Sibghatullah Farooqui, VC, AMU was the Chief Guest and Mr. Abdul Hameed, Raheem Greens, Srinagar, Prof. Javed Akhtar, Business Administration Department, AMU and Dr. Mohsin Raza, Famous Surgeon were the Guests of Honour. The function was presided over by Mr. Naseem Ahmad, IAS (Rtd), former VC, AMU and President, NUES.

4. CBSE result of 10th grade for Saiema Mansoor Public School remained 100% for the third consecutive year and for other schools it remained 97% in aggregate. Inspired by very good results, the society has taken steps to upgrade the SMPs to Senior level under affiliation to CBSE.
