

Sanjan Sanatorium Tower of Silence – representation on filthy condition of religious site of Parsi community

On December 4, 2017 a representation was received from Mr Dinshaw Tamboli, Chairman of The WZO Trust Funds on behalf of all Parsi community of Sanjan regarding the filthy condition near Sanjan Memorial Column – a historic and heritage site of the Zoroastrian Community that commemorates the arrival of Zoroastrians into India 1300 centuries earlier at Sanjan. He informed that the society opposite the main gate of Sanjan Memorial Sanatorium passed their drainage line exactly on the main gate which cause for severe leakage of drainage water, dirty smell throughout the day and an eyesore for all the Parsi community guest who come to visit the place from around the world, also causing the great inconvenience while entering or leaving the premises. The hawkers also started using the Udwa road Sanjan and started encroaching on main road leading towards Sanjan Column. The matter was taken up by M(KKD) at different levels over the past several months and made correspondences with the all concerned Government authorities of Valsad. Official visits/meetings also been arranged with the Collector, DDO, Mamlatdar (Sanjan), and other government officials of Valsad to resolve the issue amicably. After these meetings on 27th September, 2018 a confirmation on action has been received by the office of M(KKD) wherein they stated that the necessary action has been taken and matter has been resolved.
