I Visited Gwalior on January 17,2018 . The Administration of District Gwalior welcome to me at railway station.

They also told me their grievances as Sikh community they are facing especially they mentioned a case one person by name Arpit Sharma S/o Bhagwat Sharma R/o Physical Road Shivpuri loaded a wrong quotation in his facebook **“chidia nal baj ladava ”sava lakh se ekala ladh java, tab Arpit Sharma Nam padava Arpit Sharma Name is sufficient ”**

After the strong protest of Sikh community police registered a case against accused Arpit Sharma U/S 295 A IPC under IT Act 2004/section 67A on 10-1-2018. The people of Sikh community told me that we are

not well aware informations the Centre Government is doing for the welfare of Minority Communities.
