Record Note of the Meeting of the National Commission for Minorities held on 12th June, 2024

A meeting of the National Commission for Minorities was held at 11:30 A.M on 12th June, 2024 in the Chamber of Hon'ble Chairman.

- (5) Agenda Item No.1: Confirmation of the record notes of the Meeting of the Commission held on 08.05.2024.

Confirmed.

(6) Agenda Item No.2: Tour report of Shri Dhanyakumar Jinappa Gunde to Karnataka and Maharashtra from 15th February, 2024 to 04th March, 2024.

Following recommendations were approved.

(1) Karnataka State Government may be advised to provide training to the officials of State Minority Commission and all other offices to promote the schemes provided for the benefit of minorities in both Urban and Rural areas of the State.

- (2) The State Government of Karnataka may be advised to verify the status of disbursement of benefits of the schemes and to increase the budget and quota slab so that more beneficiaries could avail the benefits.
- (3) The State Government of Karnataka may be advised to take initiatives in promotion of the schemes being run by the Union Government and to look into the status of disbursement of financial assistance provided for the benefit of minorities.

For the recommendation Nos. (1), (2) & (3), letters would be sent to the State Government.

(7) Agenda Item No.3: Note received from the M (DJG) regarding interim report in the matter of Gwalior National Heritage.

Deferred to the next meeting.

(8) Agenda Item No.4: Pendency Status on CMS portal from 06.05.2024 to 02.06.2024.

Pendency Status on CMS portal from 06.05.2024 to 02.06.2024 was placed before the Commission. It was observed that VC meeting with Chief Secretary of States/ UTs may be convened to review the reports pending for more than three months with them. Prior to the meeting, copies of letters by which grievance petitions were forwarded to the States/ UTs, may be shared with them by e-mail.

(9) Agenda Item No.4: Status of CPGRAM Grievances till 04.06.2024.

Status of CPGRAM Grievances till 04.06.2024 was placed before the Commission. It was informed that no CPGRAM Grievance is pending beyond the deadline of 30 days.

- (10) Agenda Item No.5: Any other items with the permission of the Chairman:
- (1) The Commission unanimously resolved as follows:-

"India, under the dynamic leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has been making significant progress on all fronts. People of the country in light of the developmental activities have once again reposed their faith in the leadership of the Hon'ble Prime Minister. The implementation of 'SABKA SAATH, SABKA VIKAS, SABKA VISHWAS, SABKA PRAYAS' has generated confidence amongst the minorities who are eager to contribute to the goal of a Viksit Bharat @2047. The Commission hereby resolves to continue working for the developmental goal of the Government and adopts this Resolution."

- (2) The full Commission would visit Ayodhya to pay obeisance and visit religious places like Ram Temple, Gurudwara, Jain Temple, Mosque, Buddhist religious places, etc.
- (3) A media briefing to be convened with regard to Roadmap of the Commission for upcoming days including 100 days Action Plan.
- (4) Research Consultants may be directed to research media reports on daily basis and put up to the respective Members under whose guidance they are working. In this regard, specific States/UTs may be assigned to Research Consultants.
- (5) A VC meeting to be convened with Chief Secretary of Gujarat in the matter of 'Girnar Hill related to Jain Community'.
- (6) SOP for handling grievance petitions in NCM may be formulated.
