- In Andhra Pradesh minorities such as Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, and Parsis constitute **8.8%** of the state's population.
 - The Government of Andhra Pradesh established CEDM in **1994** to reduce the socio-educational backwardness of minorities and to provide them with sustainable opportunities in competitive exams and skill development.
 - As part of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation, the main center was established in Vijayawada in **2017**, along with 3 regional centres in: Kurnool, Guntur, and Visakhapatnam.
 - CEDM operates with the primary goals of elevating educational standards and expanding employment opportunities for minority students in the state.
