The 2027 edition, which will be held in the February-March window, is set to be the **39th National Games**. Meghalaya will be the host state for the first time.

Hosting the National Games will not only promote sports and tourism but also create opportunities for local youth, entrepreneurs, and communities. The event is seen as a symbol of Meghalaya's progress, cultural pride, and commitment to empowering the next generation through sports and development.



Meghalaya Sports Ecosystem

Meghalaya has a dynamic sports ecosystem with a major focus on youth development, adventure tourism, and traditional indigenous games. Preparing to host the **39th National Games in 2027**, the state is heavily investing in infrastructure, including the upgradation of the Jawaharlal Nehru Sports Complex in Shillong.

Football & Mainstream Athletics

- **Football:** It is the most popular sport in Meghalaya. The state hosts the Meghalaya State League and several top-tier local clubs like Mawlai SC.
- **State & Regional Games:** Annual Meghalaya Games are held to bridge modern and traditional sports, acting as a direct talent pipeline for regional events.

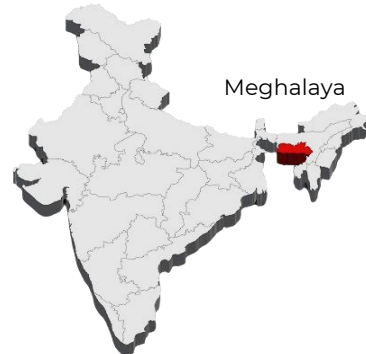
Indigenous & Traditional Sports

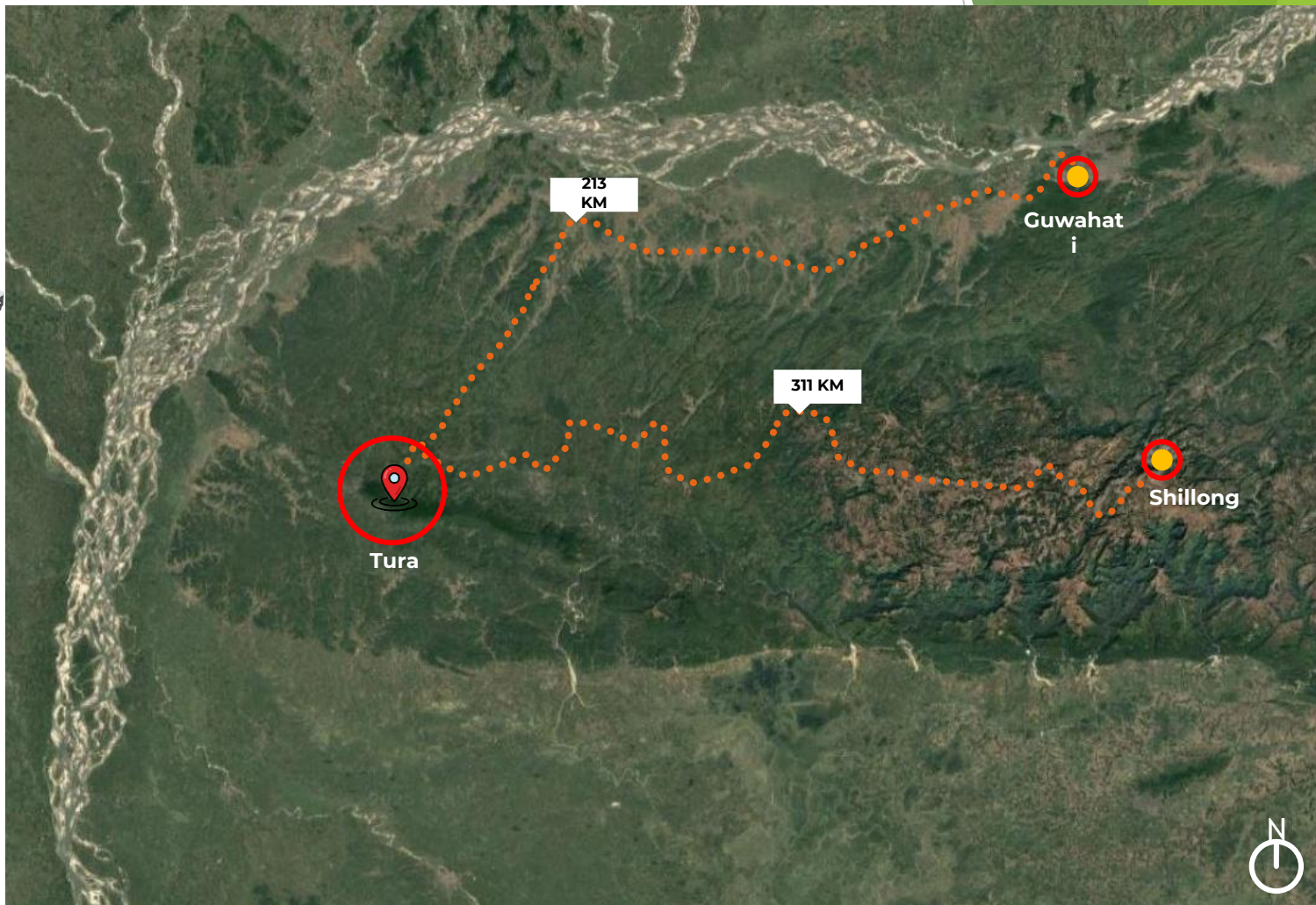


Site Connectivity

Projects under PMJVK in Meghalaya

The Construction of Medical Skill Development Hunar Hub (300 bedded hospital, Nursing College, Paramedical College and Pharmacy College alongwith hostels) is a ₹152 crore project under construction in Babadam, West Garo Hills. As one of Northeast India's largest medical skill centers, it will train 2,500 students in nursing, paramedics, and pharmacy to boost regional healthcare capabilities.

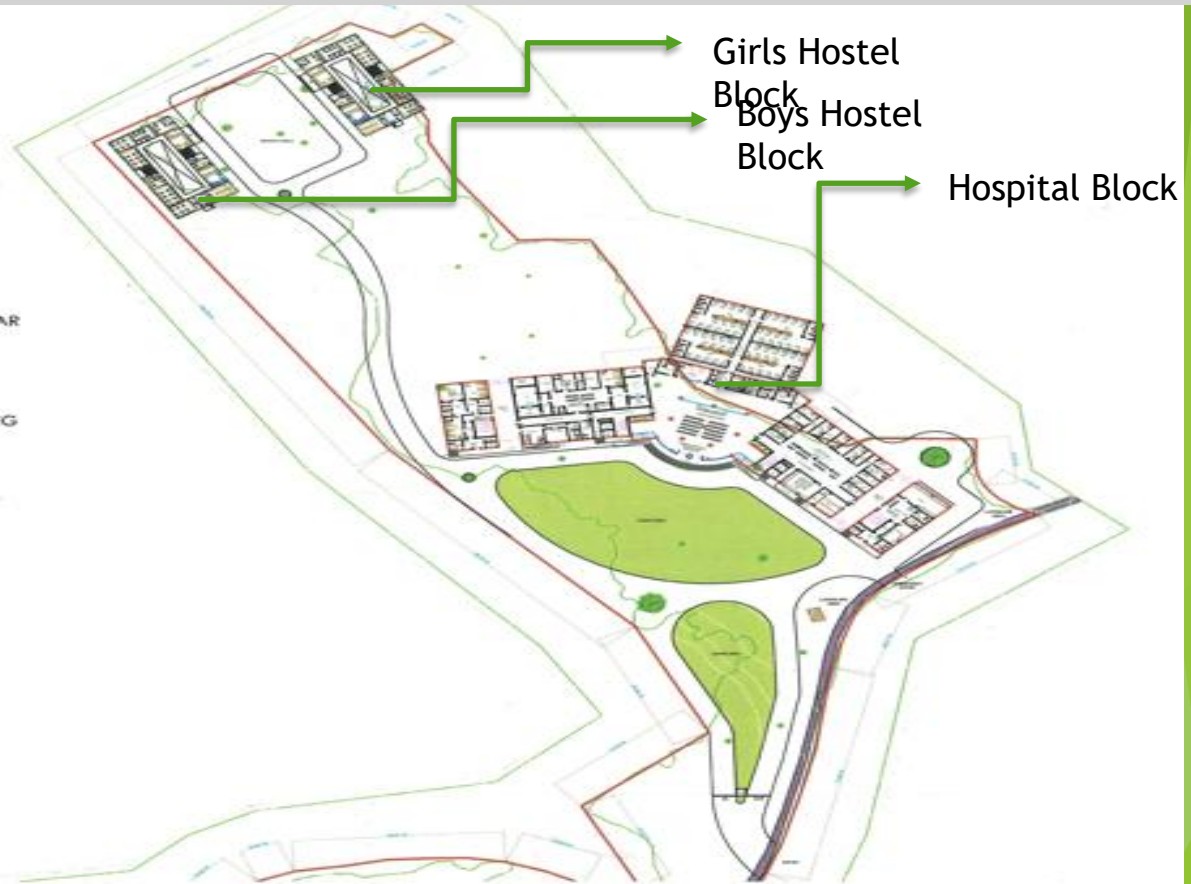

Site Plan of Medical Skill Hub

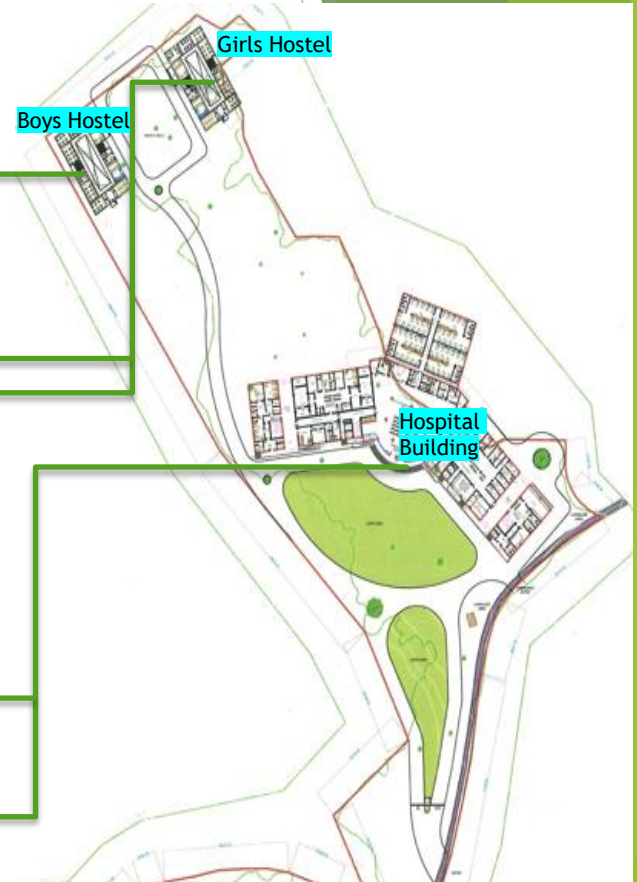
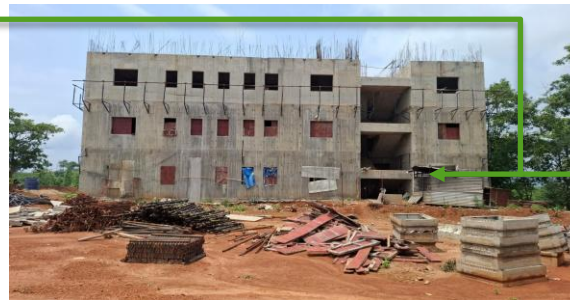

P.A Sangma Stadium

- ▶ The PA Sangma Stadium was constructed under the scheme Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram, Ministry of Minority Affairs. It was approved in the year 2019-2020 with a total cost of Rs. 96,67,00,000/- on 90:10 sharing pattern. The Stadium comprises of four units viz;
- ▶ Upgradation of P.A. Sangma Outdoor Stadium.
- ▶ Indoor Sports Hall - 1 at Dakopgre.
- ▶ Indoor Sports Hall - 2 at Dakopgre.
- ▶ Development of External and Outdoor Stadium at P.A. Sangma Stadium.

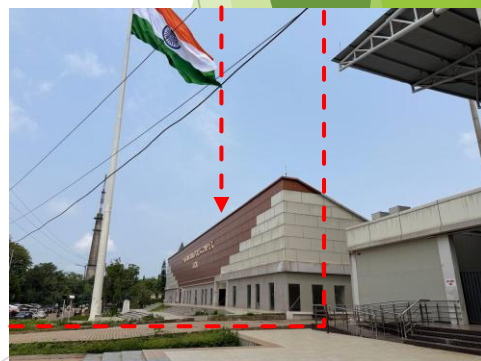
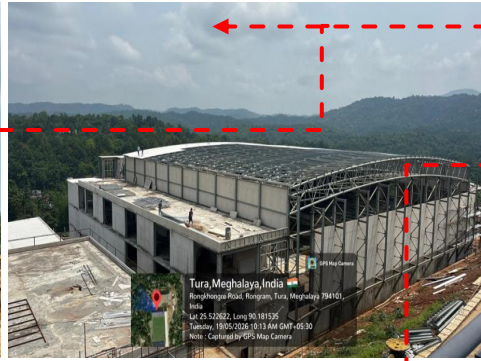
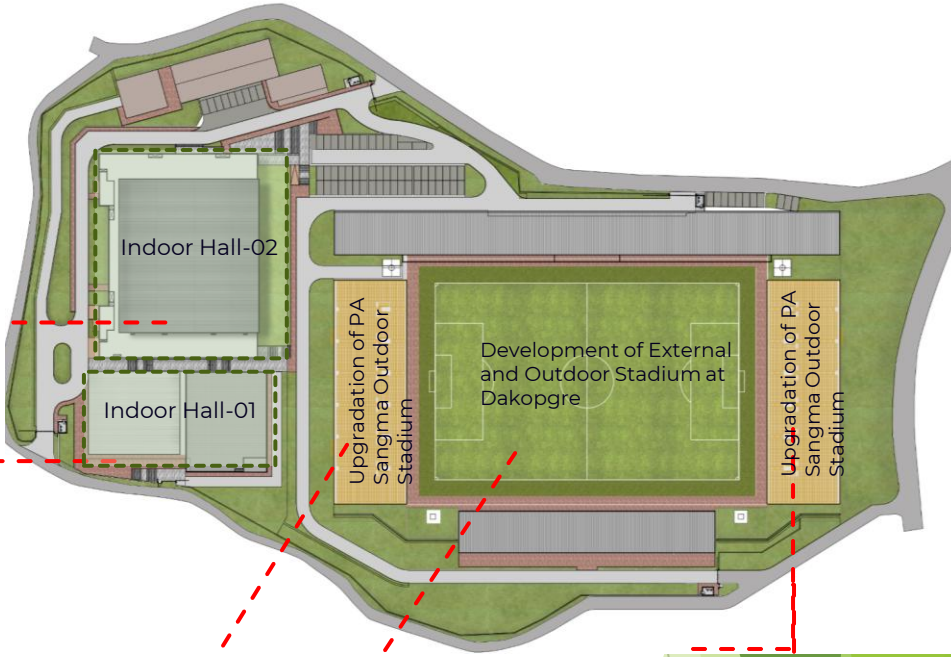
Site Plan

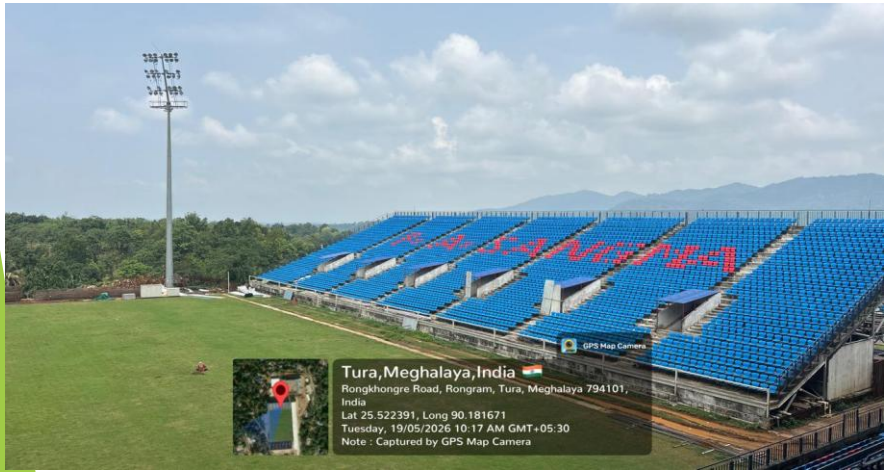

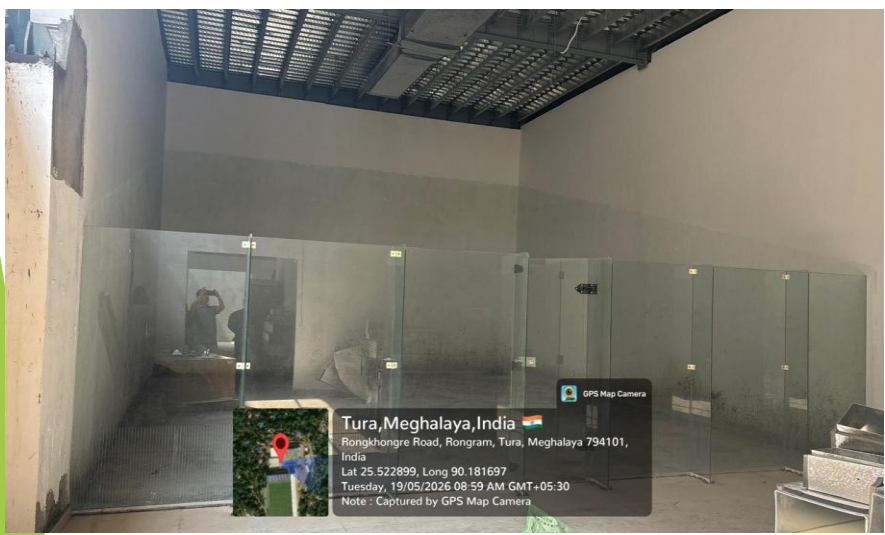

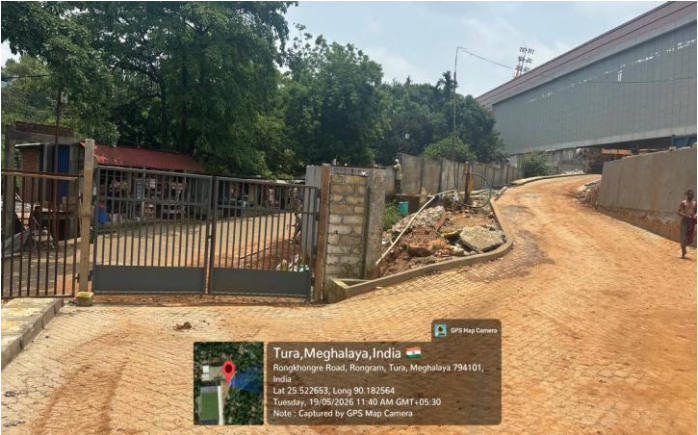
